- Keep consistent, reliable records, including, but not limited to, daily attendance, individual student records, report cards and permanent records.
- Is responsible for the care and maintenance of the classroom and will maintain an inventory of classroom textbooks, teaching materials, equipment and furniture.
- Attend community meetings, faculty meetings, open houses, professional development opportunities and in-service days.
